Any emails sent before 9.00am on Friday 29 July 2022 will not be considered. A maximum of 5 tickets can be purchased by each organisation in this way. There is no restriction on the number of people who can attend from an organisation if single tickets are purchased through the members' login area.

Delegates purchasing tickets for this event must have been ARDL members since before 1 May 2022. If any tickets remain on sale by 9am on Friday 5 August 2022 then individuals who have become an ARDL member since 1 May 2022 will be eligible to purchase one.
